### Qualify for GNT Final at Atlanta NABC - Win GOLD Points

The Grand National Teams event is a national team event with four flights that begins at the club or district level. The surviving teams from the flight finals listed above will play head-to-head matches to determine which team will represent District 24 at the ACBL Summer Nationals in Atlanta in July 2018. To be eligible you need to be a resident of District 24 (New York City and Long Island). Flight eligibility is based on master points as of September 2017:

Open: Unlimited

Flight A: Open to players with 0-6000 masterpoints

Flight B: Open to players with 0-2500 masterpoints

Flight C: Open to Non-Life Masters with fewer than 500 masterpoints

### NEW – Flight C Players must qualify at a club to play in Final on Feb 25

Club qualifiers for the Flight C GNT will be team events. Players will qualify as individuals and can form teams of qualified players for the District final. To qualify, a player must be on a team that scores in the top 50% of the field in a club event. In New York City, Aces and Honors will be holding Flight C qualification events. Bridge clubs on Long Island will be doing the same. Dates will be announced shortly. For more information check with your club.
